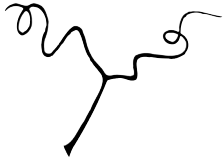
By sourcing grapes from the renowned regions of Barossa and Wrattenbully, each variety is grown in vineyards which offer some of the best regional character to each individual variety.

Pick of the Bunch

Grapes for this portfolio are hand picked and gently handled throughout the process. Selection starts during harvest and the grapes are further reduced through parcel selection. The selected grapes are the 'pick of the bunch', ensuring only the finest make it to fermentation. The results are wines of optimum quality, character and individuality.



Experience the Difference

In line with Yalumba Hand Picked's innovative wine styles and techniques, every bottle has been designed to showcase an element unique to each wine.

Yalumba Hand Picked Shiraz + Vioignier (Barossa) – The Vine Cutting represents Yalumba's pioneering work with Vioignier, both in winemaking and clonal endeavours. Using only the best Barossa fruit, the Vioignier intensifies the colour of Shiraz, contributing fragrant aromas and adding a silkiness to the texture and liveliness to the palate.

Yalumba Hand Picked Tri-centenary Vines Grenache (Barossa Valley) – The tricentenary vines speak for themselves. From grapes grown on bush vines planted in 1889, they produce a wine of great structure and tremendous flavour – a true Barossan Grenache.

Yalumba Hand Picked Mourvèdre + Grenache + Shiraz (Barossa) – Affectionately referred to as MGS, this wine combines the robust characters of Mourvèdre, balanced by the perfume of Grenache and the spice of Shiraz.

Yalumba Hand Picked Tempranillo + Grenache + Vioignier (Barossa) – Taking the Spanish variety of Tempranillo and blending it with Grenache and Vioignier was an irresistible challenge that has resulted in a rich, savoury wine with a tight tannin structure offering the perfume and softness of Grenache and the exotic fragrance of Vioignier.

Yalumba Hand Picked Late Harvest Vioignier (Wrattenbully) – The 'terroir' of Wrattenbully combined with the alluring qualities of Vioignier and the richness and concentration of late harvested fruit, combine to produce opulent flavours of apricots and peaches. An exotic and luscious wine.
