

# Yalumba The Signature Cabernet Sauvignon & Shiraz (Barossa)

## Quintessentially Australian

The Cabernet Sauvignon and Shiraz blend is a uniquely Australian wine and one to which Yalumba has remained true since the 1960's with 'The Signature'.

As well as acknowledging the best of vintage, this wine has paid homage to the people who have enhanced the traditions and culture of Yalumba since 1962 and continues to do so to this day.



## History of The Signature

The idea for 'The Signature' was borne from a comment at the annual dinner of the Stock Exchange of Adelaide, when then Prime Minister Sir Robert Menzies stood with a glass of the 1961 Yalumba Galway Vintage Special Reserve Claret in his hand and declared, "Gentlemen, this is the finest Australian red wine I have ever tasted." Sir Robert's comment was the inspiration for a series of wines to commemorate extraordinary individuals.

## A Sentimental Favourite

Amongst the 40 'signatories' to date, there have been many note worthy recipients recognised for their contribution to the culture and tradition of Yalumba. An exception occurred in 1999, the year of the company's 150th anniversary, when 'The Signature' was dedicated to every person who has worked for Yalumba.

"'The Signature' gives me the privilege of saluting the best of vintage of Cabernet Sauvignon and Shiraz. It combines an appreciation of the past, and the growing and crafting of our own Barossa future," said winemaker Kevin Glastonbury.
